


ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 28, 2011. ATX Telecommunications Services, Ltd. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to resell interexchange long distance services in Tennessee in 2000. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 14, 2000, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. A transfer of authority to ATX Licensing, Inc. was approved *nunc pro tunc* in Docket No. 05-00093.¹ On November 23, 2010, ATX Licensing, Inc. requested that the TRA cancel its authority.² Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant ATX Licensing, Inc.'s request to cancel its authority.


IT IS SO ORDERED.
