**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Ron Jones, Director Pat Miller and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 15, 2006. OnePoint Communications-Georgia, LLC (the "Company") originally filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing telecommunications services in Tennessee on February 15, 2000. During a Hearing held on August 4, 2000, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On May 6, 2004, an Order was issued in Docket No. 03-00523 approving a transaction whereby the assets and CCN of the Company were transferred to Verizon Avenue Corp. On February 28, 2006, Verizon Avenue Corp. requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel Verizon Avenue Corp.'s CCN to provide competing telecommunications services in Tennessee.
