
ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF  
CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

This matter came before Chairman Tre Hargett, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 8, 2008. Total Environmental Solutions, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide water utility services in Hardeman County, Tennessee, on June 15, 2000 in conjunction with its filing for a transfer of authority from Riviera Utilities of Tennessee, Inc.<sup>1</sup> During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 10, 2000, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On May 20, 2008, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
