**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Director Robin Bennett and Director David F. Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 7, 2014. Globalcom Inc. d/b/a GCI Globalcom Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on June 23, 2000. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 1, 2000, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. A name change to Globalcom, Inc. d/b/a First Communications ("Globalcom") was approved by the Authority on January 26, 2009 in Docket No. 08-00212.

Globalcom merged into First Communications, LLC ("FCL"), with FCL surviving the merger.¹ On August 9, 2013, the Authority received a request from Globalcom and FCL to cancel Globalcom's authority since Globalcom no longer exists as a separate corporate entity. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the request for cancellation.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
