


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 26, 2009. National Telecom, LLC (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on July 24, 2000. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 21, 2000, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On September 18, 2009, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.


