**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Ron Jones, Director Pat Miller and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 23, 2006. U.S. TelePacific Corp. d/b/a TelePacific Communications (the "Company") originally filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee on August 8, 2000. During a Hearing held on December 14, 2000, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On January 11, 2006, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel the Company's CCN to provide competing local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee.
