ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 23, 2009. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by Z-Tel Communications, Inc. (the "Company") on October 3, 2000. During a Hearing held on March 21, 2001, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application, thereby expanding the Company's authority to provide telecommunications services in Tennessee. On May 27, 2008, the Company requested that the Authority cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
