
**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Director Eddie Roberson, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 23, 2006. Thomas-Leo Marshall (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on October 18, 2000. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 23, 2001, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. On August 2, 2006, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Thomas-Leo Marshall to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
