

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 22, 2010. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide facilities-based and resold competitive telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by IDS Telcom LLC (the "Company") on December 13, 2000. During a Hearing held on May 16, 2001, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application.¹ On November 25, 2009, the Company requested that the Authority cancel its CCN.² Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.

¹ Transfer of the Company's CCN to IDS Telcom Corp. was approved by the Authority on April 18, 2005 in Docket No. 05-00048. A name change to IDS Telcom Corp. d/b/a Cleartel Telecommunications was approved by the Authority on November 20, 2006 in Docket No. 06-00265.

² The Company's customer base was transferred to Birch Telecom of the South, Inc. d/b/a Birch Communications of the Southeast. *See In re: Joint Petition of Birch Telecom of the South, Inc. d/b/a Birch Communications of the Southeast and IDS Telcom Corp. and Now Communications, Inc. for Expedited Approval of Transfer of Customer Base*, Docket No. 09-00074. The Company stated that it has no customers or active operations in Tennessee.
