

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Director Pat Miller, Director Sara Kyle and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 6, 2007. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local exchange telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by Dixie-Net Communications, LLC (the "Company") on January 29, 2001. During a Hearing held on October 30, 2001, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On August 17, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.


