


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 30, 2007. Texas HomeTel, Inc. d/b/a 877 Ring Again (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on February 8, 2001. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 3, 2001, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On March 19, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.<sup>1</sup>
