Dear Mr. Waddell:

The purpose of this letter is to confirm our understanding of that the due date for filing post hearing briefs for Phase I of the subject docket is March 1, 2002. The Authority set the due date as seven calendar days after BellSouth submitted its response to Interrogatory No. 36. Apparently, BellSouth filed that response with the Authority on February 21st. Because of the size and format of the response, it was not practical for BellSouth to email or fax that response to the parties. Accordingly, BellSouth sent the response to the other parties via overnight delivery and we received that delivery on February 22nd. Since it is our understanding that the Authority intended to provide the parties with seven calendar days after actually receiving the response within which to file their briefs, we assume that the due date for briefs is Friday, March 1st.
