**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE RESOLD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Vice Chair Kenneth C. Hill, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission" or "TPUC"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on December 9, 2019. Reduced Rate Long Distance, LLC ("RRLD" or the "Company") was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission on August 7, 2001.

On October 29, 2019, the Commission received a request from RRLD to cancel its authority to provide telecommunications services in Tennessee. The cancellation request from RRLD stated that the Company has no customers in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
