ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Vice Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard and Director David F. Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 21, 2013. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide facilities-based and resold interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by USCarrier Telecom, LLC ("USCarrier" or the "Company") on June 12, 2001. During a Hearing held on September 13, 2001, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application.

USCarrier and its parent company merged with and into Zayo Group, LLC ("Zayo"), with Zayo surviving the mergers.¹ On July 3, 2013, the TRA received a request from Zayo to cancel USCarrier's CCN since the Company no longer exists as a separate corporate entity. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant Zayo's request to cancel USCarrier's CCN.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
