
ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Pat Miller of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 25, 2007. Qwest Interprise America, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on June 28, 2001. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 10, 2001, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On October 19, 2006, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee, effective ninety days from the date of the request. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Qwest Interprise America, Inc. to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.¹
