
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**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**


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This matter came before Chairman Tre Hargett, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 28, 2008. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services throughout the State of Tennessee was filed by East Tennessee Network, LLC<sup>1</sup> (the "Company") on August 21, 2001. During a Hearing held on November 7, 2001, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On April 25, 2008, the Company requested that the Authority cancel its CCN.<sup>2</sup> Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.


