ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Tre Hargett and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 5, 2008. QX Telecom LLC (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on October 1, 2001. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 12, 2002, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On April 10, 2008, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
