

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Tre Hargett and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 5, 2008. QX Telecom LLC (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on October 1, 2001. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 12, 2002, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On April 10, 2008, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority.<sup>1</sup> Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
