Dear Mr. Hicks:

In recent deliberations on interconnection agreements filed for approval, questions have arisen regarding inconsistencies between the agreement and previous Authority decisions. The four interconnection agreements were deliberated and approved by the Authority at the December 4, 2001 regularly scheduled conference. At the December 4th Conference the Authority also required that the orders approving the above agreements include a footnote listing any areas that are inconsistent with previous Authority orders.¹

In accordance with the Authority's December 4th directive, please provide by 12:00 noon on January 10, 2002, a document outlining any areas of the agreements referenced above that are inconsistent with previous TRA decisions. Additionally, all future interconnection and/or resale agreements should explain in detail, as part of the filing, any areas of the agreement that differ from previous Authority decisions.

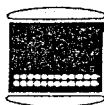
