On December 17, 2001 AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. (AT&T), a Delaware corporation, filed documents with the Delaware Secretary of State converting the form of its business structure from a corporation to a limited liability company in accordance with Delaware law. The new name of the business is AT&T Communications of the South Central States, LLC (AT&T-LLC). The Tennessee Regulatory Authority (TRA) approved the transfer of AT&T's certificate of public convenience and necessity to AT&T-LLC by order dated December 5, 2001 in Docket No. 01-00937. Inasmuch as AT&T-LLC is a continuation of the same business of AT&T, the TRA has authorized AT&T-LLC to operate pursuant to the tariffs of AT&T that were on file at the TRA immediately prior to the conversion. Consequently, the AT&T tariffs currently on file with the TRA and to which this letter is attached should be considered the lawful and current tariffs of AT&T-LLC.
