ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE  
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE



This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Pat Miller and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 20, 2007. Corral of Columbus LLC d/b/a Golden Corral (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on November 14, 2001. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 4, 2001, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application.<sup>1</sup> On July 25, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Corral of Columbus LLC d/b/a Golden Corral to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.


