**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Vice Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard and Director David F. Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 7, 2014. Appliance & TV Rentals, Inc. d/b/a Fones-4-U ("Appliance & TV Rentals") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on April 24, 2000 in Docket No. 00-00326.<sup>1</sup> During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 23, 2000, the Directors found that Appliance & TV Rentals had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application.

The authority granted to Appliance & TV Rentals was transferred to Ring Connection, Inc. ("Ring Connection" or the "Company") in this docket during a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 16, 2002.<sup>2</sup> On December 11, 2013, the Authority received a request from Ring Connection to cancel its authority.<sup>3</sup> Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
