**ORDER REVOKING AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE COCOT SERVICES
IN TENNESSEE FOR NON-PAYMENT OF FEES**

This matter came before Chairman Tre Hargett, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 8, 2008 to cancel the authority of JLR Communications, Inc. (the "Company") to offer Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service in Tennessee due to non-payment of fees.

The Company originally filed an Application to provide COCOT service within the State of Tennessee on January 23, 2002. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 26, 2002, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application.

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(b) (2004), every owner or operator of a public pay telephone shall submit to the TRA an annual inspection and supervision fee for each service location on or before July 1 of each year. A notice was sent to the Company on April 7, 2008 regarding its failure to comply with the requirements of Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(b) (2004).

That notice was returned as undeliverable, and further efforts to reach the Company by telephone were unsuccessful. As of the September 8, 2008 Authority Conference, the Company had failed to submit its annual inspection and supervision fee to the Authority.

Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to revoke the authority of the Company to provide COCOT service in Tennessee due to non-payment of fees.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

As a result of the non-payment of fees, the authority granted to JLR Communications, Inc. to provide COCOT service within the State of Tennessee is revoked, and this docket is closed.
