# ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 20, 2015. Cypress Communications Operating Company, Inc.<sup>1</sup> ("Cypress" or the "Company") filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on June 28, 2002. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 5, 2002, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On February 20, 2015, the TRA received a request from Cypress to cancel its authority, stating that it would cease operations in Tennessee effective March 31, 2015. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.<sup>2</sup>
