ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE

This matter came before Chair Robin L. Morrison, Vice Chair Kenneth C. Hill, and Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission" or "TPUC"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on July 15, 2019. Jaroth, Inc. d/b/a Pacific Telemanagement Services ("PTS" or the "Company") filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") Service within the State of Tennessee on July 17, 2002. During a Commission Conference held on August 5, 2002, the Commissioners found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-04-02-.43 through 1220-04-02-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On May 14, 2019, the Commission received a request from the Company to cancel its authority. Based upon careful consicleration of the record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
