**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE RESELL TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN TENNESSEE**

---

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Clay R. Good, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on May 8, 2023.<sup>1</sup> Henderson Payphone Service (“Company”) was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Commission on September 23, 2002.

On December 7, 2021, the Commission received a request for cancellation of authority from Henderson Payphone Service. The cancellation request asserted that the company no longer has customers receiving any services for which it is required to maintain a certificate. Therefore, as there are no customers being served, the cancellation of its certification will have no adverse consequences for consumers in Tennessee.

Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company’s request to cancel its


authority.
