**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Vice Chairman Robin L. Morrison and Director Herbert H. Hilliard of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 13, 2017. 3U Telecom Inc. (the "Company") filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee in 2002. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 2, 2003, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. A name change to Telecom North America Inc. ("Telna") was approved by the Authority on August 22, 2011 in Docket No. 11-00120. The TRA received a request from Telna on November 29, 2016 to cancel its authority. Telna stated that it is no longer doing business in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant Telna's request to cancel its authority.
