

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Pat Miller of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 5, 2007. Business Options, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on October 1, 2002.¹ During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 16, 2002, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On January 23, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.

¹ The Company was granted authority to provide resell telecommunications services in Tennessee by the Tennessee Public Service Commission on April 16, 1996 in Docket No. 96-00533. That Authority was revoked by the TRA at an Authority Conference held on March 26, 2002 for failure to provide a surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit as required by Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-125(j). See *Order Granting Certificate to Resell Telecommunications Services* (April 3, 2003).
