

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Director Eddie Roberson, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 28, 2011. A.R.C. Networks, Inc. d/b/a InfoHighway (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to resell interexchange long distance services in Tennessee on October 16, 2002. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 2, 2002, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On November 23, 2010, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
