
**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Pat Miller of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 16, 2007. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services, including exchange access telecommunications services, in Tennessee was filed by Cat Communications International, Inc. (the "Company") on November 12, 2002. During a Hearing held on May 6, 2003, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On February 5, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
