
**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE CUSTOMER OWNED
COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Vice Chair Kenneth C. Hill, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission" or "TPUC"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on July 15, 2019. Kroger Limited Partnership ("KLP" or the "Company") filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") Service within the State of Tennessee on November 12, 2002. During a Commission Conference held on December 2, 2002, the Commissioners found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-04-02-.43 through 1220-04-02-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On June 25, 2019, the Commission received a request from the Company to cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
