JOINT REQUEST FOR SIXTY-DAY SUSPENSION OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Aeneas Communications, LLC and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T") jointly request that the procedural schedule in this case be suspended for sixty days while the parties continue their negotiations toward a settlement.

At this time, the parties are discussing a settlement which may resolve all the remaining issues in this docket. As part of this settlement, the parties are also discussing a new interconnection agreement between the parties. The complexity of a new agreement has necessarily prolonged the negotiations. Nevertheless, the parties believe that they will eventually reach agreement.

For these reasons, the parties jointly ask that the procedural schedule be suspended for sixty days. The undersigned has been asked by counsel for AT&T to confirm AT&T's request for this extension.


