**ORDER GRANTING JOINT REQUEST FOR SIXTY-DAY  
SUSPENSION OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the January 30, 2009, filing of a *Joint Request for Sixty-day Suspension of Procedural Schedule* ("Joint Request") by the parties, Aeneas Communications, LLC and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee. The *Joint Request* asks the Hearing Officer to suspend the procedural schedule<sup>1</sup> sixty days to allow the parties to continue their negotiations toward settlement. The parties further indicate that such settlement discussions have been progressing and may, ultimately, resolve all issues remaining in the docket. The Hearing Officer finds that the parties' request is not unreasonable.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

The *Joint Request for Sixty-day Suspension of Procedural Schedule* is GRANTED and the procedural schedule is hereby tolled for a period of sixty (60) days.
