**ORDER CANCELLING AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Ron Jones, Director Pat Miller and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 10, 2006. Metro Teleconnect Companies, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange telecommunications services in Tennessee on December 6, 2002. During a Hearing held on March 11, 2003, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On December 29, 2005, the Company notified the TRA that it will no longer be providing telecommunications services in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel the Company's CCN to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange telecommunications services in Tennessee.


