**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Vice Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 16, 2014. William H. King (the "Company")¹ originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on December 11, 2002. During an Authority Conference held on January 6, 2003, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On May 20, 2014, the TRA received a request from the Company to cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
