

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 30, 2007. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local exchange telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by Texas HomeTel, Inc. d/b/a 877 Ring Again (the "Company") on December 18, 2002. During a Hearing held on March 24, 2003, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On March 19, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.¹


