**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE RESOLD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chair Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission" or "TPUC"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on January 22, 2019. NobelTel, LLC. ("NobelTel" or the "Company") was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission") on April 24, 2003 in Docket No. 02-01319.


On November 28, 2018, the Commission received a notice of discontinuance and request to voluntarily relinquish its authority and cancel applicable tariffs. The Company stated in its request that the Company offered prepaid calling cards and had no presubscribed customers. Therefore, no customer notice was required.

Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
