Pursuant to Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. R. 1220-4-8-.05, please accept the original and four (4) copies of this letter as notice to the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission") that BullsEye Telecom, Inc. ("BullsEye") is requesting the Commission to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") as granted in Docket No. 03-00126 on September 23, 2023, at the Commission's earliest convenience.

On June 7, 2023, Lingo Telecom, LLC d/b/a LingoComm d/b/a BullsEye ("Lingo Telecom") and BullsEye Telecom, Inc. submitted a Joint Notice of an Internal Reorganization to the Commission that resulted in a transfer of the complete customer base of BullsEye to Lingo Telecom. This transaction was completed on July 1, 2023. Since all BullsEye customers are now transferred to lingo Telecom, BullsEye is ceasing to exist as a telecommunications carrier and is requesting the cancellation of its CCN.

Customer notice is not applicable, as BullsEye no longer has any customers.
