ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE

This matter came before Chairman Kenneth C. Hill, Director Sara Kyle and Director Herbert H. Hilliard of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 10, 2012. The Town of Centerville (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on May 19, 2003. During an Authority Conference held on June 2, 2003, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On August 30, 2012, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of the Town of Centerville to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
