ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Tre Hargett, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 28, 2008. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services, including exchange access telecommunications services, within the State of Tennessee was filed by U-Dial of Tennessee, Inc. (the "Company") on June 4, 2003. During a Hearing held on July 15, 2003, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On July 2, 2008, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.


