**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Vice Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 13, 2014. Entrix Telecom, Inc. ("Entrix" or the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to resell interexchange long distance telecommunications services in Tennessee on June 26, 2003. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 8, 2003, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On December 19, 2013, the Authority received a request from Entrix to cancel its authority.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
