ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE

This matter came before the Hearing Officer on the *Application for Permission to Appear Pro Hac Vice* filed by Dulaney L. O’Roark III, attorney for MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC and Brooks Fiber Communications of Tennessee, Inc. (“MCI”). The Application was filed on January 30, 2004.

Mr. O’Roark’s Application states that he is licensed and in good standing in the State of Georgia and the State of Virginia and that no disciplinary actions or investigations are pending against him.¹ Said Counsel agrees to subject himself to the jurisdiction of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“TRA” or “Authority”) in any manner arising out of his conduct in such proceedings and agrees to be bound by the rules governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Authority.

This Application complies with Rule 19, Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court, and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, the Application by Dulaney
