


ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Mary W. Freeman, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA" or "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 23, 2010. TSI Telecommunications Network Services, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to resell local and interexchange long distance private line data transport telecommunications services in Tennessee on October 10, 2003.¹ During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 10, 2003, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On August 4, 2010, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority, stating that it has no customers or revenues in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.²

¹ A name change to Syniverse Networks, Inc. was approved by the Authority on September 13, 2004 in Docket No. 04-00214. Subsequently, a name change to Syniverse Technologies, Inc. was approved by the Authority on July 11, 2005 in Docket No. 05-00158.

² The Company was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services, including facilities-based and resold local exchange, exchange access and interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee at a Hearing held on November 1, 2007 in Docket No. 07-00207. The CCN granted in Docket No. 07-00207 was cancelled at the Company's request at the August 23, 2010 Authority Conference.
