**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Vice Chairman Robin L. Morrison and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 13, 2017. Gold Line Telemanagement Inc. ("Gold Line" or the "Company") filed an Application for authority to resell interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee on October 9, 2003. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 24, 2003, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On January 12, 2017, the Authority received a request from Gold Line to cancel its authority. The Company stated that it is no longer doing business in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
