the arbitration panel's decisions regarding Issues 2b, 7(B) and 12 and clarification of the panel's decision regarding Issue 14 contained in the *Order of Arbitration Award* ("*Order*") issued on January 12, 2006. The *Order* addressed issues raised in the arbitration of interconnection agreements between the CMRS providers and the Rural Coalition of Small Local Exchange Carriers and Cooperatives (the "Coalition").³ The Coalition did not file a response to the *Petition*.

During the February 6, 2006 Authority Conference, based upon a review of the *Petition*, the Arbitrators voted unanimously to grant the *Petition* and to defer deliberations in this matter to a later date to be set by the panel.
