ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO PLEAD AND PRACTICE PRO HAC VICE, SUBJECT TO FILING OF CERTIFICATE OF GOOD STANDING

This matter came before the Hearing Officer upon the *Motion of Norman J. Kennard for Permission to Practice Pro Hac Vice ("Motion")* filed on August 1, 2012. In the *Motion*, Mr. Kennard states that he seeks to participate in the representation of the Tennessee Rural Independent Coalition ("Coalition") in association with Mr. H. LaDon Baltimore, a practicing member of the Tennessee Bar. In accordance with Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7), which incorporates by reference Rule 19 of the Tennessee Supreme Court, Mr. Baltimore filed, with his *Motion*, the affidavit of Mr. Kennard. In his affidavit, Mr. Kennard attests that he is licensed, in good standing, and admitted to practice in the State of Pennsylvania. Further, Mr. Kennard acknowledges and agrees that he will be subject to the disciplinary rules and procedures governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Tennessee Regulatory Authority.

Nevertheless, the *Motion* does not include a certificate of good standing as is required under Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7) through incorporation of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 19.

Upon review and consideration of the *Motion*, the Hearing Officer finds that the *Motion* substantially complies with Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, subject to the filing of a certificate of good standing from the court of last resort of the licensing jurisdiction in which Mr. Kennard principally practices, the *Motion of Norman J. Kennard for Permission to Practice Pro Hac Vice* to practice before the Authority in the proceedings in this matter is approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Subject to and upon the filing of a certificate of good standing in accordance with Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7), the *Motion of Norman J. Kennard for Permission to Practice Pro Hac Vice* is GRANTED.
