

**ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO PATRICK W. TURNER, ESQ. TO
APPEAR & PRACTICE PRO HAC VICE**

This matter came before the Hearing Officer upon the *Motion for Permission for Patrick W. Turner to Practice Pro Hac Vice* ("Motion") filed on September 4, 2013, by J. Richard Lodge, Esq., on behalf of AT&T Tennessee Mobility, LLC, AT&T Tennessee Personal Communications, LLC and Chattanooga MSA Limited Partnership collectively dba Cingular Wireless, and AT&T Wireless PCS, LLC dba AT&T Wireless (collectively, AT&T). In the *Motion*, Mr. Lodge, a member in good standing of the Tennessee Bar, requests that Mr. Turner, in association with Mr. Lodge, be permitted to appear and participate on behalf of AT&T in this matter. In accordance with Rule 19 of the Tennessee Supreme Court and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7), an affidavit and certificate of good standing was filed with the *Motion* attesting that Mr. Turner is admitted to practice before the Supreme Court of South Carolina and a member in good standing of the South Carolina Bar.

Upon review and consideration of the *Motion*, the Hearing Officer finds that the *Motion* complies with Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 19 and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7) and should be approved. Therefore, the *Motion for Permission for Patrick W. Turner to Practice Pro Hac Vice* is GRANTED.
