

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 17, 2011. Lea's Phone Center, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on October 29, 2003. During an Authority Conference held on December 15, 2003, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On September 2, 2011, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Lea's Phone Center, Inc. to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
