NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

On December 13, 2005, Xspedius Communications, LLC, by and for its operating subsidiaries named in this proceeding ("Xspedius"), joined with several other parties in filing a Petition for Enforcement of Abeyance Agreement in this docket. By the Petition, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") was requested to declare that BellSouth may not unilaterally amend or breach its Tennessee interconnection agreements with the parties, or the Abeyance Agreement between BellSouth and the parties, to unilaterally implement certain provisions of the *Triennial Review Remand Order*.²

The Authority has not yet issued its order resolving all of the issues presented in the Petition. However, BellSouth and Xspedius have agreed on a mutually acceptable resolution of those issues. Therefore, Xspedius hereby withdraws as a party to the Petition for Enforcement of Abeyance Agreement in the above-captioned proceeding.³
