**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Director Eddie Roberson, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 24, 2006. OCMC, Inc., d/b/a One Call Communications, Inc., d/b/a OPTICOM, d/b/a 1-800-MAX-SAVE, d/b/a AdvantTel, d/b/a RegionTel, d/b/a LiveTel, d/b/a SuperTel (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on March 11, 2004. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 10, 2004, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On June 9, 2006, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
